Rules & Regulations

Registration: Registration is finalized only when all required information is complete and reviewed by the office.

Late Entries: Entries received after the closing date will be considered by the organizer/coordinate. Late entries are subject to a late fee of \$10. Registration is on a ***first-come, first-served*** basis, and may close once the event reaches capacity. Categories without sufficient entries may be cancelled.

Event Registration Fee: Free

Event Registration Deadline for Group Performances (Category A):
Saturday, January 10, 2026 at 12 PM for Pre-CanSkate and STAR 1 & 2;
Wednesday January 21, 2026 at 9 PM for Teen/Adult group performance.

Event Registration Deadline for Other Categories (Categories B-G): Saturday, January 24, 2026 at 12 PM.

Restrictions: Single skaters are permitted to enter only one single freeskate category.

For example, registering for STAR 2 Freeskate *and* STAR 3 Freeskate is not permitted. However, STAR 2 skaters may register for both the group performance *and* freeskate and/or other categories.

Skaters may register for up to 2 categories (excluding the STAR 1 & 2 group performances) and must rank them in the order of preference on the entry form.

Categories

A. Group Performances

Pre-CanSkate

A group performance to showcase the Pre-CanSkate elements learned so far this season. Open to skaters in the Pre-CanSkate program, and reflects the level of the skater as of **January 10, 2026**. Depending on the number of entries, skaters may perform together in one or more performances.

Teen/Adult Learn to Skate

A group performance to showcase the elements learned so far this season. Open to skaters in the Teen/Adult Learn to Skate program and reflects the level of the skater as of **January 21, 2026**. Depending on the number of entries, skaters may perform together in one or more performances.

STAR 1 & 2

A group performance to showcase the STAR 1 & 2 elements learned so far this season. Open to skaters in the STAR 1 & 2 program and reflects the level of the skater as of **January 10, 2026**. Depending on the number of entries, skaters may perform together in one or more performances.

Other Categories (Deadline to submit entry form: January 24, 2026 at 12pm)

B. Freeskate STAR 2 - Gold

Programs must be choreographed to Skate Canada's Freeskate program requirements. For technical requirements and program length, please speak to your coach(es). Skaters are encouraged to dress in performance attire.

C. Ice Dance STAR 2 - Gold

Dances may be performed **solo** or **partnered**. Open to skaters in STAR 2 - Gold and Adult STAR. For technical requirements and program length, please speak to your coach(es). Skaters are encouraged to dress in performance attire.

D. Artistic STAR 5 - Gold

Programs must be choreographed to Skate Canada's Artistic program requirements. For technical requirements and program length, please speak to your coach(es). Skaters are encouraged to dress in performance attire.

E. Adult Freeskate Categories

Programs must be choreographed to Skate Canada's Adult Freeskate program requirements. For technical requirements and program length, please speak to your coach(es). *Adult STARSkaters also have the option of performing a STAR 2 - Gold Freeskate program based on their skating level.*

F. Adult Artistic Categories

Programs must be choreographed to Skate Canada's Adult Artistic program requirements. For technical requirements and program length, please speak to your coach(es). *Adult STARSkaters also have the option of performing a STAR 5 - Gold Artistic program based on their skating level.*

G. Small Group Performance

Programs may tell a story, evoke a mood, or follow a theme. Costumes and props are permitted. Open to skaters in STAR 3 and up, and Adult STARSkate. Requirements: 2 - 4 skaters per group, and a maximum program length of 1:30 minutes. Please speak to your private coach(es).
