

Private Lessons FAQ Information, Hiring and Changing Coaches

Question 1: How to Hire A Private Coach?

Answer 1: Contact the coach directly for availability and rate. You can get a list of coaches at our website at: https://www.uppercanadaskating.com/pages/About-Us/Coaches/

Question 2: Where can I find coaches' qualifications?

Answer 2: It is located on the website under the coach's name. You can also obtain a copy of coaches' qualifications from the office.

Question 3: Are coaches available on all skating days?

Answer 3: No, not all coaches work every day. You can check with the office for a listing of coaches' availabilities. Ensure the private coach is available on the session(s) your child will be skating on. The best way is to contact the coach directly.

Question 4: Are private lessons mandatory?

Answer 4: No, private lessons are only mandatory for all adult STARSkaters and skaters in STAR 3 and above sessions.

Question 5: How much do private CanSkate (ages 6-12) lessons cost?

Answer 5: You can expect private lessons to cost approximately \$10-20 per 15 minutes (private coaching fee to be paid to the private coach) **plus the private session ice fee that is to be paid to the club.** Each session/lesson is 15 minutes. Private CanSkate sessions are held in a separate session and not during the CanSkate sessions.

Question 6: Who are eligible for private CanSkate lessons?

Answer 6: Skaters who are in the <u>CanSkate 1-6 program (ages 6-12)</u> may hire a coach for private lessons <u>in addition to the group lessons</u>. Skaters who are in the <u>Teen/Adult Learn to</u> <u>Skate programs (ages 13+)</u> may also hire a private coach <u>in addition to the group lessons</u>. Private lessons for the Teen/Adult skaters take place during the last 30 min of the session.

Question 7: How much do private STARSkate lessons cost?

Answer 7: You can expect private lessons to cost approximately \$10-20 per 15 minutes.

Question 8: How are rates determined?

Answer 8: Rates are determined by individual coaches. Coaches set their own rate. Private coaching fees are paid directly to coaches. The Club is not involved in the transaction.

Question 9: Do the coaches offer only private lessons?

Answer 9: Some coaches may deliver semi-private lessons with up to 3 skaters and prices may vary. Please check with the coaches directly.

Question 10: What is the process if we are looking to change coaches? Answer 10:

- 1) Have a conversation with your current coach and advise you are looking to switch to another coach.
- 2) Ensure your future coach is able to coach your child.
- 3) Ensure that there is no outstanding balance with your current coach prior to starting with the new coach.
