Registration & Payment

Online registration only. There are waiting lists on full sessions. Registration cannot be confirmed unless submitted with full payment.

- FULL PAYMENT. Payment by **E-transfer ONLY**. We will not be accepting any other form of payment at the office. For E-Transfer, send payment to uppercanadaskating@bellnet.ca. We have set up for autodeposit. We DO NOT accept credit card payment.

- Full payment includes the yearly \$44 Skate Canada fee per skater and the Upper Canada Club Fee of \$50 per family.

Terms and Conditions

- Registration cannot be accepted from any skater with an outstanding balance.
- A \$45 fee is charged for NSF cheques.
- A \$50 processing fee is charged to all refunds.
- Application may be cancelled if full payment is not received by the due date.
- Application may also be cancelled if the skater does not show up for the first 2 weeks and has not notified us by email.
- All private coaching fees are payable directly to the skater's coach. Upper Canada is not responsible for the collection of individual coaching fees and is not involved in any disputes between the skater/parent and the private coach.
- There are no substitutions of days or make up classes.
- Skate Canada tests cannot be tried unless all outstanding balances (including test fees) are paid in full. There is a \$18.00 fee per skater to cover judges' hospitality in addition to test fees.

- Guest skating fee must be paid in full before stepping on the ice.

Schedules and prices are subject to change at the discretion of the club. Check the bulletin board or website for all changes.

Refund Policy

- **Skate Canada Fee and Upper Canada Club Fee are non-refundable.**
- **Program cancellation due to Government order** - Partial or full refund (by cheque or credit) depending on the percentage of refund the club receive from the City of Toronto for ice rental.
- Refund request due to medical situation must be in writing, addressed to the Board of Directors and accompany with a doctor's note.
- A \$50 processing fee is charged for all refunds except for program cancellation due to Government order.
- No make ups or refunds for sessions missed due to illness, vacations, holidays, competitions, tests, bad weather, maintenance, equipment failure, breakdowns, repairs or management disputes.
- No refunds for club events once the fee is submitted.

STARSkate Programs

Note: Skating up or down one level is allowed only with written permission from the Board of Directors.

STAR 3 and above skaters and Adult STARSkaters must hire a private coach for at least one 15 min. lesson on each skating day. Skating 2 days a week is recommended.

COVID Consideration: STAR 1-10

Skaters who has passed CanSkate 6 are eligible to skate on the STAR 1-10 combine session. This is to provide flexibility to the skaters and coaches in scheduling.

COVID Consideration: STAR 5-10

Skaters who are working at the STAR 5 and above levels have the option to skate on STAR 5-10 session. Skaters in the session share ice with the Adult STARSkaters.

STAR 1 -10

No formal group lessons will be provided in the session. A Coach will provide instruction/direction and supervision to STAR 1 and 2 skaters who do not have a private coach or have finished their private lesson. STAR 3 and above skaters must hire a private coach for at least one 15 min. lesson on each skating day.
Criteria: Skaters must have passed CanSkate 6

STAR 5-10

No formal group lessons will be provided in the session. Skater must hire private coach for a minimum of 15 minutes.

Criteria: Skaters should be landing a single Axel and MUST have at least passed one of the following group(s) of tests:

- (1) Complete STAR 4 Freeskate (both Elements and Program) AND Skills; OR
- (2) Complete ALL STAR 6 Dances.

Adult STARSkate

This program offers Adults the chance to improve their skating skills for recreational purposes, test and/or to compete. The Adult STARSkate session is combined with the STAR 5-10. Skater must hire private coach for a minimum of 15 minutes. **Skaters should have strong basic skating skills and are working on figure skating skills, freeskate and/ or dances.**

Private Lessons

Private coaching will help speed progress by increasing focus on each skater's individual goals and challenges. The addition of private lessons is mandatory for skaters skating on STAR 3 and above sessions and on the Adult STARSkate sessions. For the list of our **coaches** and their qualifications, refer to our website. Contact coaches directly for rate and availability.

Safety

- Rowan's Law - Concussion Awareness
Skaters who are skating at the STAR 5 and above level or in the Adult STARSkate program and are under the age of 26, parents (if the skater is under the age of 18 years), must confirm that they have reviewed the required Concussion Awareness Resources and Concussion Codes of Conduct and signed acknowledgement form. Information will be presented during the registration process.

COVID Consideration (refer to our website for details)

- Parents/Guardians must leave the arena after the skater has checked in. It is recommended that parents/guardians (especially those of young children) to remain close by and can come to the arena quickly.
- Parents of skaters 10 years and under must be able to reach the arena within 15 minutes.

- Skaters must not go on the ice until their session begins and a coach is on the ice.
- Skaters may remove their mask to skate, but as soon as skaters leave the ice surface, they must put the mask back on. This includes stepping off the ice to tie skates, rest or going to the bathroom.
- COVID waiver must be signed before the skater is allowed to skate.
- Must self-screen in accordance with current public health guidelines before heading to the club.
- Parents/guardians are not permitted beyond the check in area. Up to one accompanying parent, guardian or other adult for each skater under the age of 18 is allowed to accompany the skater to the check in area. No siblings are allowed to accompany skater and parent.
- Verbal screening will be conducted at the designated entrance.
- Must arrive not earlier than 15 minutes before start of session. Skaters must arrive in the skating clothes, skates (with hard skate guards on).
- Leave the arena immediately after your session.

Guest Skating

- **Members:** Maximum 5 guest skates with purchase of at least 1 regular session. Members are defined as skaters who are Upper Canada Home Club members and buy one regular session. Fee is \$20.
- **STAR 3 and above and Adult STARSkaters are allowed to guest skate.**
- **NEW: STAR 1 & 2 skaters who have a private coach are also allowed to guest skate this season.**

- **COVID Consideration:** There will be no guest skating for non-club members at this stage. (Refer to the Guest Skating policy on the website for details)
