Times are subject to change. **Note: 5% Discount for skating 2 days per week; 10% for skating 3 days per week; and 15% for skating 4 or 5 days per week when register before March 23, 2020. Multi-day discount is not applicable when registered after the first class.**

### Registration & Payment

**Online registration only. There are waiting lists on full sessions. Proof of age may be required. Registration cannot be confirmed unless submitted with full payment.**

- FULL PAYMENT. Payment by E-transfer, cash (exact amount please) and cheque (not post-dated) ONLY. Payable to UPPER CANADA SKATING CLUB. For E-Transfer, visit our website or ask the office for details. We DO NOT accept credit card payment.
- For new Spring members only: Full payment includes the yearly \$44 Skate Canada fee and the Upper Canada Club Fee of \$25 per family.

### Terms and Conditions

- Registration cannot be accepted from any skater with an outstanding balance.
- A \$45 fee is charged for NSF cheques.
- A \$50 processing fee is charged to all refunds.
- Application may be cancelled if full payment is not received by the due date.
- Application may also be cancelled if the skater does not show up for the first 2 weeks and has not notified us by email.
- All private coaching fees are payable directly to the skater's coach. Upper Canada is not responsible for the collection of individual coaching fees and is not involved in any disputes between the skater/parent and the private coach.
- There are no substitutions of days.

- Skate Canada tests cannot be tried unless all outstanding balances (including test fees) are paid in full. There is a \$18.00 fee per skater to cover judges' hospitality in addition to test fees.
- Guest skating fee must be paid in full before stepping on the ice.

**Schedules and prices are subject to change at the discretion of the club. Check the bulletin board or website for all changes.**

### Refund Policy

- **Skate Canada Fee and Upper Canada Club Fee are non-refundable.**
- Refund request due to medical situation must be in writing, addressed to the Board of Directors and accompany with a doctor's note.
- A \$50 processing fee is charged for all refunds.
- No make ups or refunds for sessions missed due to illness, vacations, holidays, competitions, tests, bad weather, maintenance, equipment failure, breakdowns, repairs or management disputes.
- No refunds for club events once the fee is submitted.

## STARSkate Programs

Note: Skating up or down one level is allowed only with written permission from the Board of Directors.

STAR 3 and above skaters must hire a private coach for at least one 15 min. lesson on each skating day. Skating 2 days a week is recommended.

### STAR 1

Skaters must have passed Stage 6 of the CanSkate program. Session includes a mandatory 15 min. group skills lesson & a 45 min. group freeskate/dance lesson. Skater can only leave the group lesson for 15 min. for private lesson. Helmets are not required.

### STAR 2

Skaters should be landing 3 single jumps and have passed STAR 1. (STAR 1 Skills, Freeskate AND Dance). Session includes a 15 min. mandatory group skills lesson, a 30 min group lesson (freeskate/dance) and 15 min. private/practice time. Skater can leave the group lesson for 15 min. for private lesson.

### STAR 3

Skaters should be landing 4 single jumps and must have completed STAR 2. Skaters must have passed STAR 2 Skills, STAR 2 Freeskate Elements AND both STAR 2a and b Dances. **Skater skating on the STAR 3 session must hire a private coach on each skating day.** Session includes a 15 min. group skills lesson.

### STAR 4

Skaters should be landing 5 single jumps and have passed at least one of the following group(s) of tests:  
(1) Complete STAR 3 Freeskate (both Elements & Program) AND Skills; OR  
(2) Complete ALL STAR 4 & 5 Dances

Skater must hire a private coach on each skating day. Session includes a 15 min group skills lesson.

### STAR 5-10

Skaters should be landing a single Axel and MUST have at least passed one of the following group(s) of tests:  
(1) Complete STAR 4 Freeskate (both Elements and Program) AND Skills; OR  
(2) Complete ALL STAR 6 Dances. Skater must hire a private coach on each skating day. Session includes a 15 min group skills lesson.

### Adult STARSkate

This program offers Adults the chance to improve their skating skills for recreational purposes, test and/or to compete. The Adult STARSkate session is combined with the STAR 5 session which includes a 15 min. group skills lesson. No other group lesson is provided in the Adult STARSkate session. Skater must hire private coach for a minimum of 15 minutes. **Skaters should have strong basic skating skills and are working on figure skating skills, freeskate and/ or dances.**

### Private Lessons

Private coaching will help speed progress by increasing focus on each skater's individual goals and challenges. The addition of private lessons is mandatory for skaters skating on STAR 3 and above sessions and on the Adult STARSkate sessions. For the list of our **coaches** and their qualifications, refer to our website. Contact coaches directly for rate and availability.

## Safety

### • Rowan's Law - Concussion Awareness

Under this law that all skaters under the age of 26, parents (if the skater is under the age of 18 years), must confirm that they have reviewed the required Concussion Awareness Resources and Concussion Codes of Conduct and return the signed acknowledgement form to our office before the start of the session.

Documents and printed copies of the Acknowledgement Form are available in the Mitchell Field office. Information is also available on our website.

- Parents of skaters 10 and under must remain on the premises during their child's entire session.
- Skaters must not use the viewing area or bleachers to put on or take off skates.
- Skaters must not go on the ice until their session begins and a coach is on the ice.

## Guest Skating

### For STAR 3-10 and Adult STARSkaters only

• **Members:** Maximum 5 guest skates with purchase of at least 1 regular session. Members are defined as skaters who are Upper Canada Home Club members and buy one regular session. Fee is \$20.

• **Non-members:** Maximum 3 guest skates. Non-members include home club members who don't sign up for one session. Fee is \$30. **Skater must be a current member of a Skate Canada Club.** (Refer to the Guest Skating policy on the website for details)
